



Christopher A. Burrows Memorial Scholarship

The Christopher A. Burrows Memorial Scholarship Fund was established in memory of Christopher A. Burrows, a 1976 graduate of Crescenta Valley High School and La Cañada resident, who passed away on January 9, 1999 from a malignant brain tumor. Chris Burrows was an attorney, active community volunteer, a loving husband and father of four, and devoted friend who encouraged young and old alike.

The founders of the endowment fund envisioned the Christopher A. Burrows Memorial Scholarship as a well-recognized, prestigious award for students in the Crescenta-Cañada Valley. ***Burrows Scholars*** must demonstrate a high level of academic and extra-curricular achievement, strength of character, and zest for life

In May 2012, at least four Christopher A. Burrows Memorial Scholarships for a minimum of \$2,000 each will be awarded to college-bound seniors from the Crescenta-Cañada Valley. Scholarship recipients must reside in La Cañada Flintridge, La Crescenta, Montrose, or Verdugo City and attend high school in La Cañada or La Crescenta. In 2011, Varun R. Bhadha, Jameson B. Evans, Jack J. Hale, and Anneke D. Kakebeen, were recipients of \$3,000 scholarships.

APPLICATION DEADLINE – MONDAY, MARCH 19, 2012

All materials must be postmarked by Monday, March 19, 2012 or earlier, or must be submitted to the Community Foundation of the Verdugos office by 5:00 p.m. Monday, March 19, 2012. Do not use registered or certified mail as this may delay the processing of your application.

ELIGIBILITY

The Christopher A. Burrows Memorial Scholarship awards will be given to students who demonstrate a high level of academic and extra-curricular achievement, strength of character, and zest for life. An applicant's need for financial assistance will also be a consideration. Only La Cañada Flintridge, La Crescenta, Montrose, or Verdugo City residents attending high school in La Cañada Flintridge or La Crescenta and graduating in June 2012 are eligible.

(Please note that verification of a student's college registration must be submitted before funds will be disbursed.)

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Complete the **APPLICATION FORM**, which includes the **Honors/Activities/Employment Sheet**.
2. Write a **BURROWS SCHOLARSHIP STATEMENT** on a separate piece of paper and enclose it with your application. The Burrows Scholarship Statement is a paragraph that addresses your interest in this particular scholarship and why you believe you would be a worthy recipient. Also, please tell us how this scholarship will make a difference to you financially. (Please refer to the cover letter for scholarship details.)
**** Applications without a Burrows Scholarship Statement will not be considered. ****
3. Submit a **PERSONAL ESSAY** on a separate piece of paper and enclose it with your application. For your Personal Essay, you may choose option A or B:
(A) Submit your favorite College Application Essay that tells about yourself.
OR
(B) Write a Personal Statement. The Personal Statement will enable us to learn what is important to you and what motivates you. Your Statement should discuss your background, your goals, why these goals are important to you, and how and why you believe you will achieve them. Remember, we read your Statement to find out more about you – so please take your time and compose a personal essay. Your essay should be at least 1-2 pages and typed or neatly handwritten.
4. Submit **ACADEMIC TRANSCRIPTS**: The grade transcript must include all of 10th, 11th and first semester of 12th grades and all ACT, SAT I and SAT II scores. Students should also submit transcripts for classes taken at a college, if these grades are not posted on the high school transcript. If your school has not yet recorded your SAT scores on your transcript, then submit a copy of the SAT score report you received at your home.
5. Submit one (1) **ACADEMIC RECOMMENDATION LETTER**: The letter of recommendation may be from a recent instructor or a guidance counselor. Instructors/counselors may either mail their letter directly to the Community Foundation of the Verdugos or instructors may give their letter to the student in a **sealed** envelope to include with the application.
6. Submit one (1) **EMPLOYER/SUPERVISOR/COACH RECOMMENDATION LETTER**: If you have never been employed, **you are still required to complete this obligation**. Think about other activities – have you done community service, childcare, assisted at your church, or participated in an organized activity or sport? Ask a supervisor in one of these alternate activities or an employer to write a recommendation letter.
7. **INTERVIEW**: Only qualified applicants with completed files will be considered for a personal interview. It is your responsibility to be sure your application file is complete. If you are selected for an interview, we will contact you by phone or mail in April. All other applicants will be notified of their status by mail. Scholarship winners will be selected from the interview group. **Interviews will be conducted in late April on a date yet to be determined.**
